Safe Zone Ally training reviews issues and experiences related to sexuality and identity. You'll learn about terms applicable to at-risk and marginalized students, and you'll better understand what various identities represent. (In other words, if you're not quite sure of the differences among queer identities, sexual orientations, and gender expressions—or if you've seen the acronym LGBTQIA+ but get lost somewhere in the middle, this program will help!) It's an intimate, emotional, personal, and rewarding session that helps everyone better understand the experiences of an often-overlooked population.
